A Message from Mrs Kee

We began the week with an assembly delivered virtually by the NSPCC team, the focus of which was keeping children safe. The assembly (Speak out. Stay safe.) aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse in a child friendly way. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, letting a trusted adult know about any worries they have. This was aligned with the message we delivered during our anti-bullying week too.

In Forest Schools, there has been a focus over the last few weeks on sculpting using clay and found materials in the woodlands, such as twigs, leaves, berries and feathers, to create a reindeer clay figure. The models the children created were lovely and several children came to show me their clay reindeers and were able to describe what they had used and why.



The weeks are flying by and, as we move closer to Christmas, the children in EYFS and Year 1 have been rehearsing their Christmas performances. I have been lucky enough to have a sneaky peek and can tell you that you will be in for a treat when you come to watch!

Today we had our collaborative monitoring morning where the Trust Vice CEO and the Trust Lead Practitioner came to look at learning at Violet Way. We visited classrooms and observed the children in their reading groups and English lessons in Y1 and Y2 and, in EYFS, we observed the morning routines, phonics and maths. It is always a pleasure going into classes and it was wonderful to share this with Trust leaders. Together we identified many strengths and agreed on our next steps. Just like the children, the staff at Violet Way are always reaching for the stars and want to build on what is working on, continuing to develop further. Wishing you a lovely weekend, MrsKee
