Write them in words and digits.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a variety of books at home. Your child could share a book everyday. This can be reading a book aloud everyday or sharing a book with an adult. • Oxford Owl has free eBooks if you wish to create a free account. Complete the linked Play activities for each book. • Create a bookmark, perhaps you could choose characters from your favourite stories. • Complete a book review on one of the books you have read – What was it about? What did you like about it? Would you recommend it to anyone? • With your child, look in magazines, newspapers and books for the tricky words or phonic sounds they are currently learning (these can be found in the back of their reading diaries). They could use a highlighter to highlight in magazines and newspapers.
